## **Wisconsin hits the Powerball jackpot for the second time this year!**

**\$29.1 million winning ticket sold in Brown County**

Wednesday's drawing also produces two other major winners



(Madison)—A ticket sold in De Pere matched all six winning numbers in the Wisconsin Lottery's Wednesday, September 5 Powerball drawing, laying claim to the \$29.1 million jackpot.

**The \$29.1 million winning ticket was sold at De Pere Superstore, 1501 Main Ave. in De Pere.**

Wednesday night's winning Powerball numbers were 11, 20, 21, 30 and 48. The Powerball was 18 and the Power Play multiplier was 02.

This is the 14<sup>th</sup> Powerball jackpot ticket sold in Wisconsin since the game was introduced in April 1992 and marks the first time since 1998 that Wisconsin has had more than one Powerball winner in the same calendar year. The last Powerball jackpot winner was Patrick Nowlin of Stoughton who won \$40.7 million on March 31, 2007.

Wednesday night's Powerball drawing also produced a \$200,000 winner in Pleasant Prairie and a \$10,000 winner in Oak Creek. The \$200,000 winning ticket was sold at BP Amoco, 10477 120<sup>th</sup> Ave. The Oak Creek \$10,000 ticket was sold at Potter's Piggly Wiggly, 2201 E. Rawson Ave.

All winning ticket holders have 180 days to claim their prizes.
