\$200,000 Powerball prize claimed by Burlington woman



(Madison) —Clara Eckert of Burlington made a \$5 wager go a long, long way.

Eckert purchased a \$5 ticket in the Wisconsin Lottery's September 24th Powerball drawing. She won \$200,000 by matching the five regular numbers drawn that night (05, 13, 21, 32 and 36). Had she not missed the Powerball (33) she would have won \$176 million.

After taxes, Eckert receives \$136,500.

Eckert bought her ticket at Speedway, 12221 75th St. in Kenosha.

For selling Eckert's \$200,000 winning ticket, Speedway earns a \$4,000 commission. Wisconsin Lottery retailers that sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.
