Brown Deer, Two Rivers Powerball winners claim prizes *Both won \$10,000 on October 8*



(Madison) —Two players who won \$10,000 in the Wisconsin Lottery's October 8 Powerball drawing have claimed their prizes.

Luydmila Pargamotnikas of Brown Deer won \$10,000 with a ticket purchased at the Green Bay Road Pick 'N Save in Brown Deer.

Donald Shavlik of Two Rivers won his \$10,000 Powerball prize with a ticket bought at the 22nd St. Pick 'N Save in Two Rivers.

Powerball players win \$10,000 by matching four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball in a specific drawing.

The winning numbers for October 8 were 02, 12, 17, 48 and 54, with a Powerball of 02.

For selling these two \$10,000 winning tickets Pick 'N Save earns a \$400 commission. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.
