Four big Wisconsin winners as Powerball moves to \$20 million



(Madison) —The Powerball jackpot grows to \$20 million (est. annuity) for this Saturday, October 11, after no one in any state matched all six winning numbers in the Wednesday, October 8 drawing.

Wisconsin had 4 \$10,000 winners in Wednesday night's drawing. Those winning tickets were sold in/at:

Players win \$10,000 in Powerball by matching four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball. Winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prizes.

Wednesday's winning Powerball numbers were **02, 12, 17, 48 and 54, with a Powerball of 02**. The Power Play prize multiplier was 04.



No one matched all six winning numbers to claim the jackpot in the Wednesday, October 8 Megabucks drawing. Wednesday night's winning Megabucks numbers were **07, 20, 27, 36, 37 and 49**. The Megabucks jackpot for Saturday, October 11 is \$7.3 million (estimated annuity).
