Baraboo man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize



(Madison) —James Jackson Sr. of Baraboo wasted little time in collecting the \$10,000 Powerball prize he won in this Saturday's drawing. Jackson came to the Wisconsin Lottery's Madison office this morning with his winning ticket from the weekend.

Jackson actually won \$10,004. He purchased a \$2 Powerball quick pick ticket for Saturday and won on both sets of numbers: He matched four of five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball to win \$10,000 on the first set, and matched one regular winning number and the Powerball to win \$4 on the second set.

Saturday's winning Powerball numbers were 03, 07, 17, 39 and 47, with a Powerball of 09.

After taxes Jackson takes home \$6,830.

Jackson bought his winning ticket at the 8th Street Kwik Trip in Baraboo. For selling that winning ticket Kwik Trip earns \$200. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

Jackson's \$10,000 winning ticket was one of two sold in Wisconsin for Saturday's Powerball drawing. The other, sold in Greenfield, has not yet been claimed. The ticket holder has 180 days from Saturday's drawing.

The Powerball jackpot grows to \$25 million (est. annuity) for this Wednesday, October 15, after no one in any state matched all six winning numbers in the Saturday, October 11 drawing.
