## **Wisconsin hits the Powerball jackpot \$31.4 million winning ticket sold in Marinette County \$10,000 winner also sold in Rusk County**



(Madison)—A ticket sold in Marinette County matched all six winning numbers in the Wisconsin Lottery's Wednesday, October 14 Powerball drawing, laying claim to the \$30.4 million jackpot.

**The \$30.4 million winning ticket was sold in Marinette. The retailer that sold the jackpot ticket will be announced once Lottery Security confirms the location.**

Wednesday night's winning Powerball numbers were 05, 15, 25, 30 and 40. The Powerball was 06 and the Power Play multiplier was 02.

This is the 15<sup>th</sup> Powerball jackpot ticket sold in Wisconsin since the game was introduced in April 1992. The last Powerball jackpot winner was Steve Peot of Green Bay who won \$29.1 million on September 7, 2007 on a ticket he purchased in De Pere.

Wednesday night's Powerball drawing also produced a \$10,000 winner in Hawkins in Rusk County. The \$10,000 winning ticket was sold at Hawkins Amoco, 705 Ellingson Avenue.

All winning ticket holders have 180 days to claim their prizes.
