\$200,000 Powerball prize claimed by Mosinee woman *Big ticket sold in Greenville*



(Madison) —Leah Toboyek of Mosinee is the latest big winner in the Wisconsin Lottery's Powerball jackpot game. She won \$200,000 playing Powerball this weekend.

Toboyek purchased her \$5 quick pick Powerball ticket for Saturday night's drawing at the 10 & 45 Citgo in Greenville. One set of numbers on that ticket matched all five regular winning numbers drawn Saturday, but not the Powerball, to give Toboyek the \$200,000 prize.

Saturday's winning numbers were **03, 13, 32, 38 and 48, with a Powerball of 13.**

After taxes Toboyek receives approximately \$136,500.

For selling Toboyek's winning ticket the 10 & 45 Citgo earns a \$2,000 commission. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

A second big ticket from Saturday's Powerball drawing, a \$10,000 winner, has not yet been claimed. That ticket was sold at Marks Main Street Shell, 1698 Main St. in Green Bay.
