Two \$10,000 Wisconsin winners as Powerball grows to \$20 million

Trempealeau & Vilas County stores sell winners



(Madison) —The Powerball jackpot grows to \$20 million (est. annuity) for this Wednesday, November 5, after no one in any state matched all six winning numbers in the Saturday, November 1 drawing.

Wisconsin had two \$10,000 winners in Saturday night's drawing. Those winning tickets were sold in **Blair** at Kwik Trip, Junction Hwy. 53 & 95, and in **Eagle River** at Pick 'N Save, 711 Hwy. 45 North.

Players win \$10,000 in Powerball by matching four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball. Winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prizes.

Saturday's winning Powerball numbers were **04, 06, 26, 40 and 41, with a Powerball of 15.** The Power Play prize multiplier was 04.



No one matched all six winning numbers to claim the jackpot in the Saturday, November 1 Megabucks drawing. Saturday night's winning Megabucks numbers were **03, 11, 14, 22, 25 and 47.** The Megabucks jackpot for Wednesday, November 5 is \$8.9 million (estimated annuity).
