Taylor County man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize



(Madison) —Norman Gburek of Athens made the most of the \$1 quick pick ticket he purchased for the Wisconsin Lottery's October 31 Powerball drawing, turning his \$1 wager into a \$10,000 prize.

Gburek's ticket matched four of the five winning numbers, plus the Powerball, to land him that \$10,000 prize. The winning Powerball numbers on the 31st were 02, 19, 26, 41 and 54, with a Powerball of 23.

Gburek bought his \$10,000 winning ticket at Medford Co-operative, 160 Medford Plaza in Medford. For selling Gburek's ticket the store earns a \$200 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.
