## Powerball to \$32 million; three big Wisconsin winners



(Madison) —The Powerball jackpot grows to \$32 million (est. annuity) for this Wednesday, November 12, after no one in any state matched all six winning numbers in the Saturday, November 8 drawing.

Wisconsin had one \$20,000 winner and two \$10,000 winners in Saturday night's \$25 million jackpot drawing.

The \$20,000 winner was sold in Merrill at Riiser Energy, N. 357 Brandenburg Ave.

The \$10,000 winning tickets were sold in Kenosha at Spiegelhoff's SuperValu, 3401 80<sup>th</sup> St. and in Wilson, at Kwik Trip, 531 Hwy. 128.

Powerball players win \$10,000 by matching four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball. The Merrill \$20,000 winner actually won \$10,000 but also purchased the Power Play prize multiplier feature, which multiplied his prize by two.

Winners have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim their prizes.

Saturday's winning Powerball numbers were **02, 04, 21, 36 and 40, with a Powerball of 41.** The Power Play prize multiplier was 02.
