Kenosha Powerball winner claims prize



(Madison) —Lisa Torrey of Kenosha has claimed a \$10,000 Powerball prize she won in the Wisconsin Lottery's Saturday, November 8 Powerball drawing.

Torrey bought a \$3 quick pick ticket at Spiegelhoff's SuperValu, 3401 80th St. in Kenosha. One of her three sets of numbers matched four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball in Saturday night's drawing, bringing her \$10,000.

Saturday's winning numbers were 02, 04, 21, 36 and 40, with a Powerball of 41.

For selling Torrey's \$10,000 ticket Spiegelhoff's earns \$200. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.
