## Shawano County sells fourth big lottery winner in last three weeks as Powerball moves to \$42 million



(Madison) —The Powerball jackpot grows to \$42 million (est. annuity) for this Saturday, November 15, after no one in any state matched all six winning numbers in the Wednesday, November 12 drawing.

Wisconsin had one \$200,000 winner Wednesday night and it came from a familiar place of late.

The \$200,000 winner was sold at Riiser Energy, 112 U.S. Hwy. 45 in Tigerton. It is the second large Powerball ticket and the fourth large Wisconsin Lottery ticket of any kind to be sold in Shawano County since October 25.

On November 8 a city of Shawano Lottery retailer sold a \$31,000 Badger 5 ticket. A \$62,000 Badger 5 ticket was sold in the city on October 28, and a \$10,000 Powerball ticket was sold there on October 25<sup>th</sup>. All three earlier prizes have been claimed.

Wednesday's \$200,000 winner has 180 days from last night's drawing to claim the prize.

Wednesday's winning Powerball numbers were **01, 18, 25, 29, and 45, with a Powerball of 02**. The Power Play prize multiplier was 02.



No one matched all six winning numbers to claim the jackpot in the Wisconsin Lottery's Wednesday, November 12 Megabucks drawing. Wednesday night's winning Megabucks numbers were **01, 04, 09, 21, 22 and 43**. The Megabucks jackpot for Saturday, November 15 is \$1.0 million (estimated annuity).
