West Bend man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize



(Madison) —Charles Cuchy of West Bend has claimed the lone \$10,000 prize won in Wisconsin in Saturday night's \$42 million Powerball drawing.

Cuchy's \$10,000 ticket, which he bought at Andy's Petro Pantry, 1211 Washington Ave. in West Bend, matched four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball. Saturday night's winning Powerball numbers were 03, 07, 08, 12 and 44, with a Powerball of 37.

For selling Cuchy's ticket, Andy's Petro Pantry earns \$200. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

The Powerball jackpot grows to \$50 million (est. annuity) for this Wednesday, November 19.
