## **Bruce, Burlington winners claim \$10,000 Powerball prizes** Prizes won in November 24<sup>th</sup> drawing



(Madison) —**Robert Kramer of Bruce** and **Vidleava Boland of Burlington** have each claimed a \$10,000 prize they won in the Wisconsin Lottery's Powerball drawing on November 24.

Kramer and Boland purchased \$5 quick pick tickets for the drawing on the 24<sup>th</sup> and then matched four of the five winning numbers PLUS the Powerball to win. The winning Powerball numbers were 01, 07, 13, 23 and 35. The Powerball was 19.

Kramer purchased his winning ticket at the Express Mart, 533 N. Main St., Bruce. Boland's ticket was sold at PDQ, 8800 7<sup>th</sup> St. in Kenosha.

For selling those \$10,000 winning tickets Express Mart and PDQ earn a \$200 commission. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize value, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket.
