Eau Claire man claims \$10,000 Powerball prize Chippewa Falls resident is a \$20,000 instant winner



(Madison) —Harold Paulsen of Eau Claire has validated a \$10,000 winning Powerball ticket from the November 21st Powerball drawing.

Paulsen purchased his ticket, a \$5 quick pick, at Auto Stop, 2016 17th Ave. in Bloomer. He won \$10,000 by matching four of the five regular winning numbers plus the Powerball in the 11/21 draw.

For selling Paulsen's winning ticket Auto Stop earns a \$200 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket.

A Chippewa Falls man has won \$20,000 playing the Wisconsin Lottery's "Cash Greetings Double Play" instant game.

Frank Brown purchased his winning ticket at Kwik Trip, 1010 Woodward Ave. in Chippewa Falls.

"Cash Greetings Double Play" is the Lottery's newest \$5 "combination" ticket, featuring four different scratch games on the front, and a pull tab game on the back.

For selling Brown's \$20,000 winner Kwik Trip earns a \$400 commission from the Lottery.
