Eau Claire woman claims \$10,000 Powerball prize



(Madison) — Beth Larson of Eau Claire turned a \$5 Powerball quick pick ticket into a \$10,000 winner in the Wisconsin Lottery's Wednesday, November 7th Powerball drawing.

Larson matched four of the five regular winning numbers drawn Wednesday night, PLUS the Powerball, to win \$10,000. She purchased her winning ticket at Mega Mart, 5511 Highway 93 in Eau Claire.

For selling Larson's winning ticket, Mega Mart earns a \$200 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket.

Wednesday night's winning Powerball numbers were 22, 29, 35, 46 and 52. The Powerball was 02 and the PowerPlay prize multiplier was 05.

The jackpot for the next Powerball drawing on Saturday, November 10th is \$82 million (est. annuity).
