Darlington woman claims \$10,000 Powerball prize



(Madison) — **Janice Foley of Darlington** has won \$10,000 with a ticket she purchased for the Wisconsin Lottery's November 28 Powerball drawing.

Foley matched four of five regular numbers PLUS the Powerball to win her prize. The November 28th winning Powerball numbers were 08, 23, 32, 37 and 39, with a Powerball of 38.

Foley purchased her \$10,000 winning ticket at Darlington Mini Mart, Hwy. 23 & 81 in Darlington. For selling that winner, the Mini Mart earns a \$200 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per ticket.

The jackpot for the next Powerball drawing on Wednesday, December 5 is \$20 million (est. annuity).
