## Three \$10,000 Powerball winners claim their prizes



(Madison) —Wisconsin Lottery Powerball players have been hitting some big prizes in 2007 and the year is drawing to a close with a flurry of activity.

Three \$10,000 Powerball winners from three different communities have claimed their prizes in the last few days:

- **Robert Polka of East Troy** won \$10,000 on a \$3 quick pick ticket he purchased for the Saturday, November 10 drawing at M and M Foods, 3228 W. Main St., East Troy;
- **Tammy Colward of Fond du Lac** bought a \$5 ticket for the same drawing at Pick 'N Save, 760 W. Johnson St., Fond du Lac and turned that into a \$10,000 winner;
- **Sheryl Makuski of Stevens Point** won \$10,000 with a ticket she purchased for the Saturday, November 3 drawing at Riiser Energy, 5485, Highway 10 East in Stevens Point.

All three players matched four of the five winning numbers PLUS the Powerball in their respective drawings to win the game's \$10,000 prize.

All three retailers who sold the winning tickets receive a \$200 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who selling winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000 per ticket.
