First two “Holiday Millions Raffle” \$100,000 prizes claimed Tickets sold in St. Francis and Racine validated

(Madison) — Two of the 10 players who won \$100,000 in the Wisconsin Lottery’s “Holiday Millions Raffle” game on January 1st have claimed their prizes:

David Christensen of Milwaukee

won with ticket #304081 that he bought at Pick ‘N Save on Whitnall Ave. in St. Francis.

Joseph Tromp of Waterford

won with ticket #207114 that he bought at Deli Express Foods in Racine.

Each of these \$100,000 winners receives \$68,250 after taxes.

For selling those \$100,000 winning tickets Pick ‘N Save and Deli Express Foods each receive a \$2,000 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000 per winning ticket.

The “Holiday Millions Raffle” lone \$1,000,000 prize and eight other \$100,000 prizes remain unclaimed. The \$1 million winning ticket was sold in Fond du Lac. The other \$100,000 winners were in Beloit, Brookfield, Fond du Lac, Menasha, Neenah, Prescott, Sheboygan and West Salem.

“Holiday Millions Raffle” was a limited-time on-line game offered by the Wisconsin Lottery in which 500,000 \$10 tickets were available. On January 1st the Lottery drew 511 ticket numbers from the 368,477 tickets that were ultimately sold. The first ticket number drawn became the game’s \$1,000,000 top prize winner. The next ten were each worth \$100,000. Five hundred additional ticket numbers won \$1,000 each.
