Nine of ten “Holiday Millions Raffle” \$100,000 prizes claimed \$100,000 ticket sold in Neenah still not validated



(Madison) — Nine of the 10 players who won \$100,000 in the Wisconsin Lottery’s “Holiday Millions Raffle” game on January 1st have claimed their prizes. Last week, tickets sold to players in St. Francis and Racine were redeemed. The seven latest \$100,000 winners are:

Luis Altoro of Milwaukee with a ticket bought at Pick ‘N Save on Capitol Drive in Brookfield.
Lisa Hansberry of Beloit with a ticket bought at Tex’s Grocery in Beloit.
James Hines of Mindoro with a ticket bought at the Hwy. 16 Kwik Trip in West Salem.
Matthew Isaacs of Sheboygan with a ticket bought at the Calumet Dr. Q Mart in Sheboygan.
Bradley Quimby of Appleton with a ticket bought at Piggly Wiggly in Menasha
John Scheff of Fond du Lac with a ticket bought at the Pioneer Rd. Pick ‘N Save.
Chad Stanford, Hastings, MN with a ticket bought at Price Rite in Prescott.

Just one \$100,000 winning “Holiday Millions Raffle” ticket is still unclaimed. The outstanding ticket was purchased in Neenah at the Quick Food Mart, 1305 S. Commercial. The ticket number is #157638.

The game’s lone \$1,000,000 winning ticket has also not yet been claimed.

That ticket, #300142, was sold at Ma & Pa’s Grocery Express, 506 S. Main St. in Fond du Lac.

“Holiday Millions Raffle” was a limited-time on-line game offered by the Wisconsin Lottery in which 500,000 \$10 tickets were available. On January 1st the Lottery drew 511 ticket numbers from the 368,477 tickets that were ultimately sold. The first ticket number drawn became the game’s \$1,000,000 top prize winner. The next ten were each worth \$100,000. Five hundred additional ticket numbers won \$1,000 each.

So far, 307 of the 500 \$1,000 winning tickets sold around the state have been claimed. 193 have not yet been redeemed.
