Someone's going to win \$1 million! Lottery's Holiday Millions Raffle* game underway



(Madison) —The Wisconsin Lottery's "Holiday Millions Raffle" game is on sale now, and come January 1, one of the game's 500,000 tickets WILL win \$1 million.

"Buy a ticket, get in the raffle, and maybe you're the \$1 million winner," said Lottery Director Mike Edmonds. "Someone is definitely going to win, so why not you?"

The "Holiday Millions Raffle" game is an on-line game, meaning the \$10 tickets are produced by the Lottery's terminals at its 3,800 retail locations around the state. The tickets are sold in sequential order, from 000001 to 500000.

On January 1 the Lottery will draw 511 winning ticket numbers. Five hundred people will each win \$1,000; ten people will each win \$100,000; and one lucky person will win \$1 million.

"These are some of the best odds ever of winning big prizes like this," said Edmonds. "But there are only 500,000 tickets and once they're gone...they're gone. We encourage players not to wait too long if they want to get in the game."

Whenever you buy your ticket, the Lottery advises you to sign the back of it immediately and to keep it in a safe place—a place you'll remember later. The tickets can't be redeemed until after the drawing is held on New Year's Day.

The "Holiday Millions Raffle" drawing will be held January 1 regardless of when all the tickets are sold, or if all of them are sold. If all 500,000 tickets are gobbled up in the next week, the drawing will still take place on January 1. And if all 500,000 tickets are not sold by December 31st, the Lottery will still conduct the drawing and pay the same prizes using the ticket numbers that were sold.
