Franklin man claims one of Tuesday's two \$350,000 SuperCash! prizes



(Madison) —Arthur Panter of Franklin has claimed one of two \$350,000 top prizes won last night in the Wisconsin Lottery's SuperCash! lotto drawing. Panter purchased his winning ticket at Sentry, 7140 S. 76th St. in Franklin.

After taxes, Panter receives just over \$238,000.

For selling Panter's winning ticket Sentry earns \$7,000. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

Panter's ticket and a second ticket sold in White Lake in Langlade County matched all six winning SuperCash! numbers drawn last night to win the game's top prize of \$350,000. Tuesday's winning SuperCash! numbers were 05, 09, 18, 23, 25 and 35.

The White Lake ticket has not yet been redeemed.

SuperCash! is a daily lotto game played only in Wisconsin. Players try to match the six winning numbers drawn each night from a field of 39 numbers for a chance to win prizes of \$1, \$30, \$500, and the game's top prize of \$350,000. There is also a doubler feature at no additional cost. When the doubler is drawn, every prize, excluding the top prize, doubles.

The odds of winning the SuperCash! \$350,000 top prize are approximately 1:1.6 million.
