East Troy SuperCash! winner claims \$350,000 prize



(Madison) —One of two \$350,000 winning tickets in the Wisconsin Lottery's Monday, June 1 SuperCash! daily lotto drawing has been claimed by an East Troy woman.

The latest SuperCash! top prize winner is Deborah Czernejewski of East Troy. Her quick pick computer generated ticket matched all six winning numbers in the June 1 drawing (08, 22, 25, 28, 29, 34) to win \$350,000.

After taxes, Czernejewski receives a cash payment of \$238,876.

Czernejewski bought her winning ticket at Frank's County Market, 3238 W. Main St. in East Troy. For selling that ticket Frank's earns \$7,000. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn a commission equivalent to 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

The other \$350,000 SuperCash! winning ticket from the 1st has not yet been claimed. That ticket was sold in West Milwaukee at Mac Services, 4250 W. Greenfield Ave.

SuperCash! is a daily lotto game played only in Wisconsin. Players try to match the six winning numbers drawn each night from a field of 39 numbers for a chance to win prizes of \$1, \$30, \$500, and the game's top prize of \$350,000. There is also a doubler feature at no additional cost. When the doubler is drawn, every prize, excluding the top prize, doubles.

When there are multiple top-prize winning tickets in SuperCash! the \$350,000 prize is paid on each ticket up to a maximum of 20 winners (\$7 million in prize payout). If there are more than 20 winning tickets the prize becomes pari-mutuel and the \$7 million in maximum payout is split evenly among all winners.

The odds of winning the SuperCash! \$350,000 top prize are approximately 1:1.6 million.
