Milwaukee man claims June 1st \$350,000 SuperCash! prize



(Madison) —The second of two \$350,000 winning tickets sold in the Wisconsin Lottery's June 1 SuperCash! daily lotto game drawing has now been claimed.

The winner is Touqir Hafeez of Milwaukee. Hafeez bought his \$350,000 winner at Mac Services, 4250 W. Greenfield Ave. in West Milwaukee. He matched all six winning numbers (08, 22, 25, 28, 29 and 34) to win that top prize.

The other \$350,000 ticket in the June 1 drawing was sold in East Troy and was claimed by an East Troy woman two weeks ago.

For selling Hafeez's winning ticket Mac Services earns \$7,000 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn a commission equivalent to 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

SuperCash! is a daily lotto game played only in Wisconsin. Players try to match the six winning numbers drawn each night from a field of 39 numbers for a chance to win prizes of \$1, \$30, \$500, and the game's top prize of \$350,000. There is also a doubler feature at no additional cost. When the doubler is drawn, every prize, excluding the top prize, doubles.

When there are multiple top-prize winning tickets in SuperCash! the \$350,000 prize is paid on each ticket up to a maximum of 20 winners (\$7 million in prize payout). If there are more than 20 top prize winning tickets the prize becomes pari-mutuel and the \$7 million in maximum payout is split evenly among all top-prize winners.

The odds of winning the SuperCash! \$350,000 top prize are approximately 1:1.6 million.
