South Dakota man claims \$350,000 SuperCash! prize *Bought his winner in Milwaukee*



(Madison) —The official state sport of South Dakota is rodeo. Maybe it should be lottery.

In May a Mission, South Dakota man won a \$232 million Powerball jackpot. Now, another denizen of the “Mount Rushmore State” has won the top prize in the Wisconsin Lottery’s SuperCash! daily lotto game.

Johnnie Bolds of Yankton, South Dakota claimed his \$350,000 prize late yesterday.

He bought his winning ticket at Teutonia Gas & Food, 4295 Teutonia Ave. in Milwaukee. The \$4 quick-pick matched all six winning SuperCash! numbers in the June 26 drawing: 05, 09, 12, 21, 24 and 29.

For selling that ticket Teutonia Gas & Food earns \$7,000 from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn a commission equivalent to 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

SuperCash! is a daily lotto game played only in Wisconsin. Players try to match the six winning numbers drawn each night from a field of 39 numbers for a chance to win prizes of \$1, \$30, \$500, and the game’s top prize of \$350,000. There is also a doubler feature at no additional cost. When the doubler is drawn, every prize, excluding the top prize, doubles.

The odds of winning the SuperCash! \$350,000 top prize are approximately 1:1.6 million.
