## **Onalaska woman finds buried treasure in “Pirate’s Gold” lottery game**

(Madison) — **Colleen Poth of Onalaska** followed her map to a \$25,000 treasure in the Wisconsin Lottery’s Pirate’s Gold instant scratch game.

The \$3 instant game challenges players to match their 24 map coordinates to a treasure map depicted on each ticket. If they completely uncover one of 10 different symbols in the game when they scratch off all their map coordinates, they win the corresponding prize.

Poth uncovered a treasure chest symbol, which corresponds to the game’s top prize of \$25,000. Poth receives a check for just over \$17,000 after taxes.

Pirate’s Gold went on sale April 9<sup>th</sup>. Poth’s \$25,000 prize is one of two such prizes in the game.
