Racine man turns Euchre lottery ticket into \$30,000

(Madison)— **Jake Benzow of Racine** knows a thing or two about playing his cards right. Benzow recently bought a \$3 “Euchre” scratch game from the Wisconsin Lottery and turned it into a \$30,000 pay day.

The Lottery’s “Euchre” instant game features 11 different prize levels from \$3 all the way to the game’s top prize of \$30,000. There are six “games” on each ticket and the play style is designed to mirror as closely as possible a real hand of the popular card game.

In each game on the “Euchre” scratch ticket, players scratch the “TRUMP” play spot to reveal the Trump Suit (Hearts, Diamonds, Clubs, or Spades) for that game. If the player’s YOUR CARD or YOUR PARTNER'S CARD beats both OPPONENTS' CARDS in any one game, he wins the prize for that game. Each game is played separately.
