May Madness Raffle on Sale May 1

50,000 tickets and 526 total prizes available

MADISON, Wis. - The limited-time, limited-quantity May Madness Raffle is back! The raffle has 50,000 tickets available and each play costs \$5. The last May Madness Raffle, held in 2019, resulted in a \$50,000 top prize win in Hartford.

This year's May Madness Raffle has one top prize of \$50,000, 25 prizes of \$1,000, and 500 prizes of \$100 prizes. If the five-digit number exactly matches one of the winning numbers drawn, in exact order, the ticket wins the corresponding prize. Tickets are available at all Wisconsin Lottery retailers.

Sales of this raffle start on Saturday, May 1, 2021. Tickets must be purchased before June 1, 2021 and the drawing will be held on June 1, 2021. Winning numbers will be available the evening of June 1, 2021 at wilottery.com/games/raffles and Lottery retailers. Winning tickets can be redeemed after the drawing.



Winning odds: \$50,000, 1:50,000; \$1,000, 1:2,000; \$100, 1:100. Prizes = 50.0% of sales. Odds based on 50.000 tickets sold.

Prizes not claimed within 180 days after drawing are forfeited.

Each play costs \$5 and prints on a separate ticket. A 5-digit number is printed on each May Madness Raffle ticket. Tickets are sold in numerical order starting 00001.
