\$2 Million Winning Powerball Ticket Sold in Mineral Point

Lucky ticket purchased at Triple P Express LLC

MADISON, Wis. - Someone in Mineral Point may have had a powerful night. Wednesday's Powerball drawing resulted in a \$2,000,000 winner. The winning ticket was sold by **Triple P Express LLC** (1045 Branger Dr.) in **Mineral Point**. The ticket matched all five numbers—12, 18, 20, 29, and 30 but not the Powerball number of 16. The Match 5 prize of \$1 million doubled to \$2 million because the winning ticket included a Power Play multiplier. Per Powerball rules, multipliers for \$1 million prizes can never be greater than double the prize.

The winning ticket is the largest Powerball prize sold in Wisconsin this year. Two \$1 million Powerball tickets have been sold in 2021. June 26, a player won \$1 million after purchasing a ticket from a Kwik Trip in Altoona. January 23, two players split a million-dollar win by purchasing their ticket from the Kwik Trip in Superior.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a 2% incentive. Triple P Express LLC will receive \$40,000 as part of the Retailer Performance Program Winning Ticket Incentive.

The Powerball jackpot continues to roll. The estimated jackpot for Saturday's drawing is \$258 million annuity or \$187.4 million cash.

The odds of winning the \$1,000,000 prize for matching 5 of 5 numbers are 1 in 11,688,054. Powerball drawings are Wednesdays and Saturdays at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. on Wednesday and Saturday to be included in that day's drawing. Powerball tickets are \$2 per play with the option to purchase the Power Play feature for an additional dollar which could increase potential winnings.
