Mega Millions Jackpot to \$383 Million

One year ago, Wisconsin hosted first-ever jackpot winner

MADISON, Wis. – One year ago, a Racine man became a millionaire overnight. He won a \$120 million Wisconsin Lottery [Mega Millions](#) Jackpot after purchasing a ticket from **Kwik Trip**, 4924 Spring St. in Mount Pleasant for the September 15, 2020, drawing. On Tuesday, September 14, 364 days later, there is a chance for another Wisconsinite to win big with an estimated *Mega Millions* Jackpot of \$383 million. The jackpot has been rolling since it was last won in Illinois on June 8. The Tuesday drawing will be the 28th in this current run.

The 2020 *Mega Millions* Jackpot winner was the first-ever in Wisconsin since the game debuted on January 31, 2010. In 2021, the largest Wisconsin Lottery prize won happened on Tuesday, August 31, when a \$3 million *Mega Millions* ticket was sold at the **Quick Pick BP Food/Nalia Inc.**, 14001 W. National Ave, in New Berlin.

Mega Millions tickets are \$2 per play. Tickets are sold in 45 states, the District of Columbia, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. *Mega Millions* drawings are Tuesdays and Fridays at 10 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. on Tuesday and Friday to be included in that day's drawing.

QUICK MEGA MILLIONS FACTS

- Current jackpot is \$383 million; cash option of \$277.3 million
- Jackpots start at \$20 million
- The odds of winning the jackpot are 1:302,575,350
