FEATURES AND PROCEDURES

SUPERCASH!

A. The theme and name of the game:

The name of this game is SUPERCASH!. It is a game in which the player selects a set of six (6) different numbers from one (1) to thirty-nine (39). At the player's option, numbers may be player-selected or randomly selected by computer.

The six (6) winning numbers are randomly selected by a drawing. Set prizes are awarded for matching, in any order, six (6), five (5), four (4), or three (3) of the six (6) numbers drawn.

Within each drawing described above, a drawing is also conducted to determine if the prizes awarded for matching five (5), four (4), or three (3) of the six (6) numbers drawn will double. There will be one (1) outcome drawn from a set of twenty (20) possible outcomes. Three (3) of the twenty (20) outcomes will double the above-referenced prizes (herein referred to as the "Doubler"). Seventeen (17) of the twenty outcomes will not double the above-referenced prizes. The Doubler feature is included in the price of the game. The player does not select any additional numbers or pay any additional money for this feature.

For the purposes of the Lottery's Retailer Performance Program, this game is considered a daily game.

B. The price of tickets:

- 1. The price of a ticket is one dollar (\$1.00), or such other price as set by the Lottery Division Administrator, which entitles the player to enter two (2) plays (two (2) sets of six (6) different numbers from one (1) to thirty-nine (39)) in each drawing for which the ticket is purchased.
- 2. Tickets purchased for the current drawing may also be purchased for the next six (6) drawings. In its sole discretion, the Lottery may designate that fewer than seven (7) drawings are available for purchase. Tickets may only be purchased for consecutive drawings starting with the next drawing available for purchase.
- 3. Tickets cannot be cancelled, and there are no refunds. It is the sole responsibility of the player to verify the accuracy of the game plays. The placing of plays is done at the player's own risk through a retailer who enters the plays.

C. The prize structure, including the number and value of prizes:

1. All prizes are funded solely out of the tickets purchased. Approximately fifty-two and eight-tenths percent (52.8%) of each dollar played is allocated to prizes. Prizes are awarded as follows:

- 2. In each drawing, an additional series will be drawn to determine whether the prizes double. The prizes for matching five (5), four (4), and three (3) of the six (6) numbers drawn are the only prizes that double when a Doubler is drawn. The odds of a Doubler being drawn are 1:7 in each drawing.
- 3. The Lottery Division Administrator shall have the option to specify different set amounts for all prizes except the top prize for a specified drawing or drawings.
- 4. The holder of a winning ticket may win only one (1) prize per play (set of six (6) numbers) in connection with the numbers and Doubler drawn, and shall be entitled only to the highest prize won by matching those numbers.

D. The frequency of drawings:

Drawings will be held daily, after 9:00 PM Central Time. Tickets for a drawing may not be sold after 8:59:59 PM on the evening of that drawing; all tickets sold after the 9:00 PM draw break on the day of a drawing will be issued for the next drawing(s). Drawing dates and times may be changed by the Lottery Division Administrator to meet the operational needs of the Lottery.

For a period of time, at the discretion of the Lottery Division Administrator, SUPERCASH! tickets may count towards entry in Super 2nd Chance drawings. The Wisconsin Lottery will not be responsible for any neglect, failure, or omission on the part of the U.S. Postal Service or any other delivery or courier service used to deliver a player's Super 2nd Chance drawing mailing to the Wisconsin Lottery. The Lottery assumes no responsibility or liability for Super 2nd Chance tickets that are lost, destroyed, or otherwise disqualified from participation in a drawing when such tickets are in the control of the Lottery. All tickets sent to the Wisconsin Lottery to enter the Super 2nd Chance drawings become property of the Wisconsin Lottery and will not be returned. Only tickets sent to and received at the correct address for entry into the Super 2nd Chance drawing will be eligible for the Super 2nd Chance drawing.

E. The method of selecting winners:

Winning numbers and Doublers are selected by a random drawing conducted in accordance with sec.

565.27 (2) Wis. Stats.

F. The method of making payments to winners:

- 1. Subject to Wisconsin Lottery validation procedures, an original ticket (not a copy) shall be the only proof of a game play or plays. The submission of a winning ticket, signed by one holder of that winning ticket, which shall be a single human being, to the Wisconsin Lottery or a Wisconsin Lottery retailer shall be the sole method of claiming a prize or prizes. For-profit and non-profit entities, trusts and other non-human beings are not eligible to claim a prize in this game. The Wisconsin Lottery is not responsible for lost or stolen tickets or tickets damaged after purchase such that validation information is not available to complete validation procedures on the ticket.
- 2. Tickets are void if stolen, mutilated, altered, counterfeit, unreadable, misregistered, defective, or otherwise fail validation tests. "Defective" includes but is not limited to errors in the computer software, computer hardware, code or programming of the game. The Lottery at its sole discretion reserves the right to pay any mutilated or misregistered ticket based upon the facts and circumstances of the particular claim. Such action by the Lottery is final and non-reviewable.
- 3. Prizes less than six hundred dollars (\$600) may be claimed and paid through a Wisconsin Lottery office or a Wisconsin Lottery retailer. Prizes of six hundred dollars (\$600) or more must be claimed and paid through a Wisconsin Lottery office. All prizes will be paid in cash or by check.
- 4. All tickets sent to the Wisconsin Lottery for the purpose of redemption become property of the Lottery and will not be returned.
- 5. An unclaimed top prize is not shared among those who claimed the prize. (For example: for a particular drawing there were twenty-five plays that correctly matched six of six winning numbers, but only twenty-four prize claims based on twenty-four plays are made within one hundred eighty (180) days after the drawing date. The twenty-four prize claimants are each entitled to only one-twenty-fifth (1/25) share of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) which is two hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$280,000).)
- 6. Prizes may be paid the morning after the drawing, provided calculation of authorized prize amounts is completed.
- 7. Until such time as a signature is placed upon a ticket in the area designated for signature, a ticket shall be owned by the bearer of the ticket. When a signature is placed on the ticket in the place designated, the person whose signature appears in the area shall be the owner of the ticket and shall be entitled (subject to validation requirements) to any prize attributable thereto.
- 8. The holder of a winning SUPERCASH! ticket must claim the prize within one hundred eighty (180) days after the drawing date or the prize shall be forfeited.
- 9. Pursuant to Wisconsin's Open Records law (sec. 19.31-19.39 Wis. Stats.), the Lottery is required to disclose a winner's name, place of residence and, if acquired, likeness. If a player wins and claims a prize, the Lottery may use his or her name, likeness and place of residence without compensation for any purpose. Upon claiming a prize, a winner waives any claims against the Lottery and its
